

I am writing on behalf of Prince of Peace Missionary Baptist Church (MBC), a 501 3(c) organization, located in Flint, MI. This is not a request for funding of any religious project. This is a request to help the residents of Flint, Michigan obtain contaminant free and healthy water.

The residents of Flint were horrifically impacted by our State poisoning their water. Although the State Attorney General is in pursuit of the perpetrators who created the problem, the fact remains that the problem still exists. Some State and Local officials report to the media that “the water is safe”. The fact of the matter is the water in Flint is NOT safe and no amount of word-smithing will make it safe. Bottle water sources are fast drying up. The residents of Flint still have contaminated water coming out of their drinking faucets and they are not drinking it. Humans cannot long sustain a healthy condition with insufficient water intake.



EcoloBlue, Inc., a California based company, has donated \$350,000 dollars worth of atmospheric water generators (AWGs), which produce ultra clean drinking water out of air. The donation is being made to Prince of Peace MBC. The Church is collecting applications from Flint residents who have a desire to receive the units free of charge. To the left is a photographic representation of the AWG units that are being donated.

The units are placed into the homes of Flint residents and will collect water out of the air. The collected water is then subjected to 12 stages of purification including reverse osmosis and ultra violet, as well as ten others. The end product is perhaps the cleanest water on the planet. Each unit produces up to 8 gallons of water per day at a cost of approximately 10 cents per gallon.

EcoloBlue of Michigan, LLC is an organization that is independent of EcoloBlue, Inc. EcoloBlue of Michigan, LLC was established by four Michigandians to facilitate the successful distribution of the AWG units. Although the AWGs are self sustaining, we have to prep the machines, deliver them to the recipients, provide training for their use, and then provide any/all follow-up maintenance that may be required. We are seeking funding for the nonprofit organization, Prince of Peace MBC, so that they may be able to pay for these activities.
